Study Questions

Before answering these questions, take some time to read the passage from the sermon together or on your own.

What did this sermon tell us about God?

What did this sermon tell us about us as people?

What did you hear in this sermon that applied the most to your own life?

What "what if" question are you most tempted to carry right now? How does the promise that Jesus will keep his people help you transform that question into an "even if" statement?

What are some "verdicts" that people, culture, or even your own inner voice try to place on you? How does knowing that Jesus' verdict is the one that ultimately matters help you respond to criticism, rejection, or misunderstanding?

Which of the four promises in this passage (the open door, vindication, keeping, or the unshakeable future) most encourages you right now, and why? How might that promise help you "hold on" to Jesus in your current circumstances?
