What did you hear in this sermon that applied the most to your own life?

How have you seen compromise at work in your own life? Which pressure, internal or external, do you find harder to resist?

What's something you can do to help grow your ability to resist compromise? We talked about clinging to Jesus, knowing the truth, and accountability. Which of these are you strongest in? Weakest? How could you grow in each area?

Jesus offers better satisfaction (mana), acceptance (white stone), and identity (acceptance). What can you take from each of these promises to strengthen your love for Jesus and desire to live for him?
