Study Questions

Before answering these questions, take some time to read the passage from the sermon together or on your own.

What did this sermon tell us about God?

What did this sermon tell us about us as people?

What did you hear in this sermon that applied the most to your own life?

What are some of the things/people to whom you give the most weight (glory)? If you were to compare that to the weight you give Jesus, how would those things stack up? DO you give Jesus the weight he is due? What is one thing you know you give too much weight?

How do you respond when you hear the idea that the thing you need most is to look upon the face of God? What might cause you to struggle to believe that? What is appealing about that thought? How does that thought change the way you perceive eternity?

How does seeing spiritual growth as a way to learn to see Jesus now by faith change the way you look at things like prayer, reading scripture, and communion? How does viewing worship as training your heart to give Jesus proper weight change the way you look at worship? Name some specific ways you can train your heart to give Jesus the glory he deserves.
