

Bearing Fruit to God's Glory

Key Scripture

John 15:8 – “Herein is my Father glorified, that ye bear much fruit; so shall ye be my disciples.”

Purpose

This week is about staying connected to Christ, allowing God's Word to become visible through our lives, and bearing fruit that brings Him glory.

MONDAY – The Word at Work

Read: John 1:1, 14

1. Where has God been giving you insight, but inviting you to act?
2. What is one area where the Word needs to become more visible in your life?
3. Write down one practical way you will live out God's Word this week.

TUESDAY – Light in the Darkness.

Read: John 1:5

1. Where have you felt “in the dark” recently?
2. What helps you stay connected to Jesus during difficult seasons?
3. Identify one person who needs light right now. Decide how you will show up for them this week.

WEDNESDAY – Abiding, Not Striving.

Read: John 15:1–8

1. Where might you be trying to produce fruit in your own strength?
2. On a scale of 1–10, how connected do you feel to Christ right now?
3. What pruning might God be doing in your life—and how can you remain faithful in it?

THURSDAY – Come Ready to Share.

Read: John 15:8

Prepare to Share ONE:

- An area where God is calling you to bear fruit
- A pruning season that led to growth
- A time God's light broke through darkness
