

Living Our Heritage

Key Scripture Isaiah 40:31

"But they that wait upon the Lord shall renew their strength; they shall mount up with wings as eagles; they shall run, and not be weary; and they shall walk, and not faint."

Purpose

This week is about recognizing the heritage we've received, honoring the sacrifices made before us, and choosing to live intentionally so that we leave a legacy of faith, hope, and love for the generations coming behind us.

MONDAY – Remember the Heritage. Read: Isaiah 40:28–31

- What does the word heritage mean to you personally (family, faith, culture, or values)?
- What opportunities do you have today that previous generations may not have had?
- How are you currently using—or neglecting—those opportunities?
- What responsibility comes with what I've been given?

TUESDAY – From Wandering to Purpose. Read: Proverbs 3:5–6

- Are there any areas of your life where you feel like you're drifting or unsure of direction?
- What does it look like for you to trust God instead of leaning on your own understanding?
- What is one decision or area where you need clearer direction right now?
- Where do I need to stop wandering and start walking with intention?

WEDNESDAY – Waiting Without Wasting Read: Psalm 27:13–14

- When you hear "wait on the Lord," what emotions come up for you?
- How can waiting be active rather than passive in your daily life?
- What might God be developing in you during this season of waiting?
- How am I partnering with God while I wait?

THURS- Finite Disappointment, Infinite Hope Read: 2 Corinth 4:16–18

- What disappointment have you experienced that still weighs on you?
- How does this passage help you see beyond temporary setbacks?
- What would it look like to hold onto hope even while acknowledging pain?
- What does hope look like for me right now?
