

# When the Wine Runs Out

**Key Scripture** John 2:1–11

## **Purpose**

This week is about recognizing that when resources run low, hope feels thin, or options seem gone – God is not finished. Crisis is not the end of your story. It may be the beginning of your miracle.

### **MONDAY- When You Feel Empty.**

**Read: John 2:1–3**

- Where in your life do you feel like you've "run out" – energy, patience, clarity, resources, joy, confidence?
- How do you typically respond when you realize something important is gone?
- Do you bring those moments to Jesus first – or try to fix them yourself?
- What area of my life feels "out of wine" right now?

### **TUESDAY – Bring It to Jesus.**

**Read: John 2:4–5**

- Mary brought the problem to Jesus before she had a solution. What does that teach you about prayer?
- Is there something you've been hesitant to bring to God?
- What might "Do whatever He tells you" look like in your current situation?
- What is God asking me to obey – even if I don't fully understand it?

### **WEDNESDAY – Obedience Before Outcome.**

**Read: John 2:6–8**

- The servants filled the jars with water before seeing a miracle. Where is God asking you to move first?
- What small act of obedience have you been delaying?
- What's one practical step you can take this week with what you already have?
- What are my "water jars" – the resources, skills, connections, or opportunities already in my hands?

### **THURSDAY- God Uses What You Have.**

**Read: Philippians 4:19**

- In what area have you been saying, "I'm not enough" or "I don't have enough"?
- What would change if you believed God can multiply what you offer?
- How does God's abundance challenge your current thinking?
- Where have I underestimated what God can do through me?
