

A Faith That Jesus Can Trust

John 2:23–25

Purpose

This week is about examining the depth of our faith. Not whether we believe in Jesus, but whether our faith is rooted deeply enough that He can entrust Himself to us.

MONDAY: Why Do I Believe?

Read: John 2:23

1. What first drew you to Jesus — a need, a miracle, a moment, a relationship?
2. Is your faith strongest when things are going well?
3. How do you respond when God doesn't meet your expectations?
4. Is my faith based on what Jesus does — or who He is?

TUESDAY – What's In My Heart?

Read: Jeremiah 17:9–10

1. Where have you trusted your feelings more than God's Word?
2. Are there motives in your faith that need refining?
3. If God searched your heart today, what might He lovingly confront?
4. What might be shaping my faith more than I realize?

WEDNESDAY – Presence Over Performance

Read: Matthew 7:21–23

1. Do you ever find yourself “doing for God” more than “dwelling with God”?
2. If no one saw your spiritual life, what would it look like?
3. Are you reading Scripture to know Him — or to prepare something for others?
4. Would I still pursue God if no one applauded it?

THURSDAY – Staying at Any Cost

Read: James 1:22–25

1. What has God asked you to stay faithful in, even when it's hard?
2. Where have you been tempted to quit because it's uncomfortable?
3. What would committed faith look like in your current season?
4. What would I still obey if it cost me something?
