Psalm 32, 115, and 103 (ESV)

Psalm 32 – A Maskil of David

- ¹ Blessed is the one whose transgression is forgiven,
whose sin is covered.
- ² Blessed is the man against whom the Lord counts no iniquity,
and in whose spirit there is no deceit.
- ³ For when I kept silent, my bones wasted away
through my groaning all day long.
- ⁴ For day and night your hand was heavy upon me;
my strength was dried up as by the heat of summer. *Selah*
- ⁵ I acknowledged my sin to you,
and I did not cover my iniquity;
I said, "I will confess my transgressions to the Lord,"
and you forgave the iniquity of my sin. *Selah*
- ⁶ Therefore let everyone who is godly
offer prayer to you at a time when you may be found;
surely in the rush of great waters,
they shall not reach him.
- ⁷ You are a hiding place for me;
you preserve me from trouble;
you surround me with shouts of deliverance. *Selah*
- ⁸ I will instruct you and teach you in the way you should go;
I will counsel you with my eye upon you.
- ⁹ Be not like a horse or a mule, without understanding,
which must be curbed with bit and bridle,
or it will not stay near you.
- ¹⁰ Many are the sorrows of the wicked,
but steadfast love surrounds the one who trusts in the Lord.
- ¹¹ Be glad in the Lord, and rejoice, O righteous,
and shout for joy, all you upright in heart!

Psalm 115

- ¹ Not to us, O Lord, not to us, but to your name give glory,
for the sake of your steadfast love and your faithfulness!
- ² Why should the nations say,
"Where is their God?"
- ³ Our God is in the heavens;
he does all that he pleases.
- ⁴ Their idols are silver and gold,
the work of human hands.

- ⁵ They have mouths, but do not speak;
eyes, but do not see.
- ⁶ They have ears, but do not hear;
noses, but do not smell.
- ⁷ They have hands, but do not feel;
feet, but do not walk;
and they do not make a sound in their throat.
- ⁸ Those who make them become like them;
so do all who trust in them.
- ⁹ O Israel, trust in the Lord!
He is their help and their shield.
- ¹⁰ O house of Aaron, trust in the Lord!
He is their help and their shield.
- ¹¹ You who fear the Lord, trust in the Lord!
He is their help and their shield.
- ¹² The Lord has remembered us; he will bless us;
he will bless the house of Israel;
he will bless the house of Aaron;
- ¹³ he will bless those who fear the Lord,
both the small and the great.
- ¹⁴ May the Lord give you increase,
you and your children!
- ¹⁵ May you be blessed by the Lord,
who made heaven and earth!
- ¹⁶ The heavens are the Lord's heavens,
but the earth he has given to the children of man.
- ¹⁷ The dead do not praise the Lord,
nor do any who go down into silence.
- ¹⁸ But we will bless the Lord
from this time forth and forevermore.
Praise the Lord!

Psalm 103 - Of David.

- ¹ Bless the Lord, O my soul,
and all that is within me,
bless his holy name!
- ² Bless the Lord, O my soul,
and forget not all his benefits,
- ³ who forgives all your iniquity,
who heals all your diseases,
- ⁴ who redeems your life from the pit,
who crowns you with steadfast love and mercy,

- ⁵ who satisfies you with good
so that your youth is renewed like the eagle's.
- ⁶ The Lord works righteousness
and justice for all who are oppressed.
- ⁷ He made known his ways to Moses,
his acts to the people of Israel.
- ⁸ The Lord is merciful and gracious,
slow to anger and abounding in steadfast love.
- ⁹ He will not always chide,
nor will he keep his anger forever.
- ¹⁰ He does not deal with us according to our sins,
nor repay us according to our iniquities.
- ¹¹ For as high as the heavens are above the earth,
so great is his steadfast love toward those who fear him;
- ¹² as far as the east is from the west,
so far does he remove our transgressions from us.
- ¹³ As a father shows compassion to his children,
so the Lord shows compassion to those who fear him.
- ¹⁴ For he knows our frame;
he remembers that we are dust.
- ¹⁵ As for man, his days are like grass;
he flourishes like a flower of the field;
- ¹⁶ for the wind passes over it, and it is gone,
and its place knows it no more.
- ¹⁷ But the steadfast love of the Lord is from everlasting to everlasting
on those who fear him,
and his righteousness to children's children,
- ¹⁸ to those who keep his covenant
and remember to do his commandments.
- ¹⁹ The Lord has established his throne in the heavens,
and his kingdom rules over all.
- ²⁰ Bless the Lord, O you his angels,
you mighty ones who do his word,
obeying the voice of his word!
- ²¹ Bless the Lord, all his hosts,
his ministers, who do his will!
- ²² Bless the Lord, all his works,
in all places of his dominion.
