1. What is an Apostle? Who can be one? Are there true living Apostles today? *Please note this is Bible Study, so let's try to back our assertions up with scripture.*
2. What is a Prophet? Are there true living Prophets today?
3. What is a saint? Who are saints? What do you have to do to become a saint?
