3. What do you learn about God in these chapters and how has that changed what you believe about Him?

4. What do these passages reveal about human nature, sin and our need for God?
5. What's the Good News found in this text?

Every week, you'll see five unique application questions. Use them to help live out what you're learning in scripture. Pray for life transformation.

1. Now that you're halfway through the Bible reading plan, what one word or short phrase summarizes the Bible? Why did you choose that word/phrase?
2. Now that you're halfway through the Bible reading plan, what are you celebrating in the story of God?
3. Now that you're half way through the Bible reading plan this year, how are you being transformed? Is anything different?
4. Now that you're halfway through the Bible reading plan, what's the most profound truth God has revealed to you in scripture? How would we know?
5. Now that you're halfway through the Bible reading plan, what is one practical next step you need to take with God?
