Application Questions

Every week, you'll see five unique application questions. Use them to help live out what you're learning in scripture. Pray for life transformation.

1. Who or what do you turn to in a time of need?
2. When was the last time you were given a gift that was undeserved or unearned? How did it make you feel?
3. What evidence would others see that you are walking in a manner worthy of your calling? Are you an imitator of God? How so?
4. Both in Exodus and Philippians, we hear about grumbling. Are you a grumbler? If so, why? How does Philippians 2 encourage you to live?
5. Time and time again, God calls us to obey. Is this something that comes easily for you? Why or why not?
