1. How seriously do you take sin? How do you deal with it?
2. Are there areas of your life that you're tempted to believe God isn't concerned about? Which areas and why wouldn't he care?
3. Does submitting to God feel like a burden or is it a comfort to you? Why?
4. How do you Sabbath? How do you keep yourself from doing too much?
5. How does the Word of God affect your day to day life? (Heb 4:12)
