Ghillian was seven months pregnant and in need of prenatal care and Brian was looking for a job. Both threw themselves into the care of our Lord and He was mighty to save.

They started attending Grace Church and Brian was baptized and found a full-time job at a local plastics factory. The Mission had a baby shower while Ghillian was able to receive the care she needed at the Bay Clinic. Next, God delivered them a car! Then, while Ghillian was in labor and giving birth to Grady, a healthy baby boy, God gave them a place to live.

Brian and Ghillian have been overwhelmed by what our Lord has done in their lives in such a short time. Brian's favorite bible verse is Philippians 4:13 "I can do all things through Christ who strengthens me." Both are enrolled in the Mission's aftercare program so they can continue to receive help and support.



Mission update;

It has always been the goal of the Mission to have a certified drug and alcohol counselor on staff at the Mission full time. That process has begun. The Mission's Care Coordinator, Bonney, completed her schooling this last summer and has started her 1,000 required hours of internship at Bay Area First Step. She will continue to oversee resident care while working three days at the Mission and two days at BAFS. It is amazing that community partners can work together for the benefit of others.
