Her husband of forty years passed away six years ago and ever since she has struggled to find housing that did not involve her being taken advantage of in one form or another. Seventeen of those years were spent in ministry.

Robin brings pure joy wherever she goes. She even bounces around with a child's enthusiasm for life. It is absolutely contagious, that spirit of joy she brings.

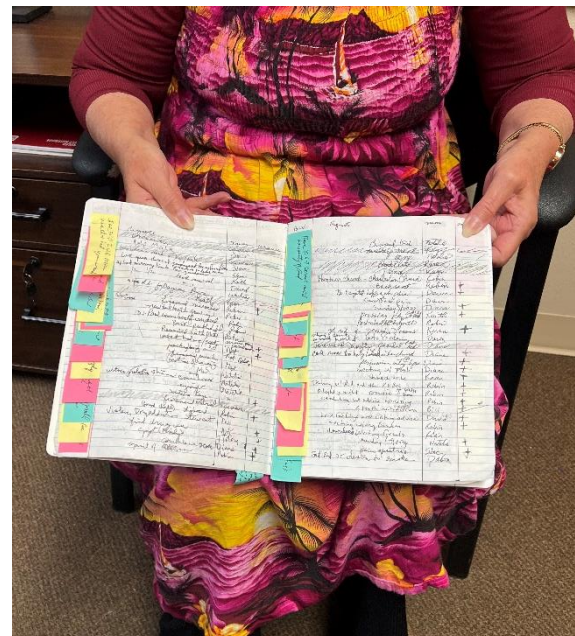
I said good morning to Robin just the other day and learned of an amazing thing I just had to share with you. Two weeks ago Robin started a prayer book. In the book is the name of the person requesting prayer, the payer itself and on the side Robin has put a corresponding scripture that goes with the prayer. Robin is also keeping track of when the prayers get answered. Answered prayers are marked with a small cross next to their name.

In two weeks Robin has filled five pages with prayer requests and the best part is that she has put forty-four crosses next to names! That's right, God has answered forty-four prayer requests. I think it's also important to note that Robin isn't the only one praying for the prayer requests in this book. Many residents and also staff have stepped up to join Robin in prayer.

Robin is a true soldier for Christ and she is not done yet. She plans on continuing to keep writing down prayer requests and keeping track of when they are answered. If you have a prayer request Robin would like you to send that prayer request to the Mission and she will write it down in her book and then she, along with many other disciples of Christ can begin praying for you.
