Our goal is to support parents in being the primary spiritual leaders of their kids. These guides are designed to encourage conversations at home before the lessons are taught at church.

2 - 3 Years

TOPIC

The Boy Who Shared His Lunch Pt 1 (Mark 6:30-44)

QUESTIONS

- How many loaves of bread and pieces of fish did the people have with them?
- What did Jesus do with the fish and bread?

BIG IDEA

Because Jesus is God, He is able to provide for his people and care for them as a shepherd cares for his sheep.

4 - 5 Years

TOPIC

Jesus Heals Bartimaeus (Luke 18:31-43)

MEMORY VERSE

Everyone who calls on the name of the Lord will be saved **Romans 10:13**

QUESTIONS

- I wonder why Bartimaeus thought Jesus could help him?
- I wonder why Jesus healed Bartimaeus?
- I wonder why the people praised God?

BIG IDEA

Bartimaeus has faith in who Jesus is and cries out to him for mercy. After Jesus heals Bartimaeus and releases him from the effects of sin, he follows Jesus.

K - 2nd Grade

TOPIC

Jesus Seeks Zacchaeus (Luke 19:1-10)

MEMORY VERSE

Everyone who calls on the name of the Lord will
be saved **Romans 10:13**

QUESTIONS

- I wonder what made Zacchaeus lost until he met Jesus?
- I wonder why the crowds were so angry about Jesus spending time with him?
- Why do you think Zacchaeus changed after Jesus found him?

BIG IDEA

Jesus has come to seek and save the lost - even unlikely people like Zacchaeus!

3rd - 5th Grade

QUESTION

What are the last two commandments?

ANSWER

Do not lie or be jealous of your neighbor.

VERSE

“For the whole law can be summed up in this one command: Love your neighbor as yourself.”

Galatians 5:14

BIG IDEAS

- The last commandments are to not lie or be jealous of your neighbor.
- INSTEAD, we should be jealous for the things of God, it actually helps us love our neighbor.
- AND loving our neighbor is the whole point of the law.
