March 19, 2023

1. Delegates to the March 18 Presbytery Meeting (Bob Shepherd, Janet and Chuck Pohla) shared pictures of the First Presbyterian Church in Navasota where the meeting was held. The advised of three disciplinary cases – sexual abuse, fraud, and threatening behavior. The discipline dispensed in each case was appropriate. There were three motions submitted for approval that either added to or deleted existing language in certain sections of the Book of Order, all of which failed. The Presbytery's finances are similar to ours with a loss of pledges, but they have enough resources to get through another year.
