- 1. FPC Conroe will host a Prayers of the People (POP) Training Day for the Presbytery Churches located in the North Houston region on Thursday, May 18, 2023, from 8:30 a.m.-4:00 p.m. POP will provide the training materials on the day of training and will serve a light breakfast and a "working" lunch of salads and sandwiches. Phase I is the day of classroom style training held in the church; Phase II is the practical training which takes place within the hospital setting.
