Our Week—Monday morning, we will travel to San Diego, where we will check in with Amor Ministries, cross the border, and set up our camp in the Amor campground.

Tuesday, Wednesday, and Thursday, we will hand-mix concrete to pour the 11'x22' slab; frame the two-room structure; wrap, chicken wire, stucco, and roof it. Doors and windows will be installed and, when the house is complete, the keys and a Bible will be presented to a grateful family.

Evenings back at camp will include good food, campfires, and recounting the events of the day.

Friday morning, we break camp and head home, knowing one more family has an adequate home.

Amor Ministries provides each mission team with the tools and resources that are necessary to build a home alongside a family in need. Amor carefully selects the home site, provides standard building plans, and equips each group to complete a home in about 4 days. While on an Amor Trip, teams will stay in conditions similar to those of the families they are serving.

Since 1980, Amor has been perfecting the house-building process in Mexico, making this the safest, most efficient, affordable trip possible. An Amor house is a simple design, built according to the standards of the community so that a group without skilled labor or power tools can still complete the project.

Passports Are Required For ALL participants

All persons are required to have a passport.

Routine passport applications are currently processing in approximately 4-6 weeks from the time of application.

Adults: Passport Book, \$130; Passport Card, \$30
Minors (under 16): Passport Book, \$100; Passport Card, \$15
(All options also charge an additional \$35 Acceptance Fee)

Expedited passport applications are currently processing in approximately 2-3 weeks from the time of application.
(Additional \$60 fee applies)
