**Mission to Mexico** is a hands-on building trip. No experience necessary. You can make a difference by providing the labor to build a home for a family desperately in need of adequate shelter. If you can hammer a nail, saw a piece of wood or shovel sand: you are qualified to change people's lives.

**Our Week**—Monday morning we will travel to San Diego where we will check in with Amor Ministries; cross the border and set up our "tent city" in the Amor campground.

Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday, we will hand-mix concrete to pour the 11'x22' slab; frame the two-room structure; wrap, chicken wire, stucco and roof it. Doors and windows will be installed and, when the house is complete, the keys and a Bible will be presented to a grateful family.

Evenings back at camp will include good food, campfires and the knowledge that our sore muscles mean a family now has a home.

Friday morning we break camp and head back to the USA; knowing we have made a difference.

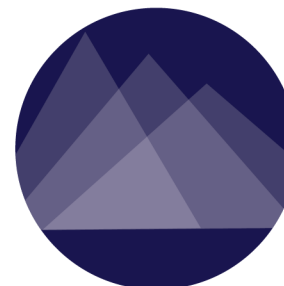

## Amor Ministries

*provides each missions team with the tools and resources that are necessary to build a home alongside a family in need. Amor carefully selects the home site, provides standard building plans, and equips each group to complete a home in about 4 days. While on your Amor Mission Trip, missions teams will stay in conditions similar to those of the families they are serving.*

*Since 1980, Amor has been perfecting the house building process in Mexico, making this the safest, most efficient, affordable trip possible. We've worked with over 374,000 volunteers to build over 19,700 homes.*

*An Amor house is a simple design, built according to the standards of the community so that a group without skilled labor or power tools can still complete the project.*

*The need is still staggering for millions of families in Mexico.*

## Passports Are Required For ALL participants

Applications are available online at  
[travel.state.gov/passport](http://travel.state.gov/passport)

**All persons are required to have a passport.** Birth Certificates for children under 18 are no longer accepted.

Routine passport applications are currently processing in approximately **6-9 weeks** from the time of application.

Adults: Passport Book, \$130; Passport Card, \$30  
Minors (under 16): Passport Book, \$100; Passport Card, \$15  
(All options also charge an additional \$35 Execution Fee)

Expedited passport applications are currently processing in approximately **3-5 weeks** from the time of application.  
(Additional \$60 fee applies)
