

IDAHO YOUTH CAMP ~ CODE OF CONDUCT

1. ALL Campers will be under the supervision of their cabin leaders at all times.
2. Alcohol, tobacco, and illegal drugs are strictly prohibited. ALL medication brought to camp MUST be turned into the camp nurse.
3. ALL electronic devices (cell phones, i-pods, i-pads, etc) must be turned upon arrival to camp. Your devices will be given back to you at the end of camp (you may use your phone to take pictures on the last day of camp). The devices will be stored in a zip lock baggie with the camper's name on it for safe keeping.
4. NO fireworks, firearms, knives, or weapons of any kind are allowed.
5. If a camper is found responsible for stealing, vandalism, or fighting, they or their parents/guardians will be required to pay all damages.
6. ALL campers are expected to attend all camp activities unless excused by the deans and/or nurse.
7. ALL language, behavior, and clothing must be appropriate and modest according to the Christian faith.
8. ALL campers and workers must adhere to the dress code. In general, clothing deemed immodest or inappropriate by the camping staff for particular activities will not be allowed.
The following guidelines should be observed:
RECREATION: Play Clothes; no tank tops, sleeveless shirts, strapless tops or halter tops, shorts of modest length are allowed, and athletic shoes.
SWIMMING attire should be modest and may consist of swim trunks, one-piece suit, tankini that meets the waist line of swim bottom, swim shirt and swim shorts or a combination thereof.
EVENING WORSHIP: Campers should wear nice casual clothes for the worship service.
9. Everyone at camp will be expected to help keep the grounds and facilities clean. Rooms will be checked daily.
10. ALL automobiles are to remain parked until camp is dismissed. No one may leave the grounds without special permission from the Camp Directors. This includes campers and staff.
11. NO camper is to be out of their room after "lights out".
12. Any breach of proper conduct or disregard of camp rules will result in disciplinary action. serious or repeated infractions will result in dismissal from camp.
13. I have read and understand the staff guidelines. I also understand my role and responsibility.

Cathedral Pines Additional Rules

1. Do not climb the mountain behind the camp.
2. Do not swim in, drink from, throw people, trash or otherwise act carelessly around the river.
3. Do not move the mattresses. Their placement in the buildings are designed for camper safety. The bunks are labeled head and foot to keep campers from being coughed or sneezed on, which can spread germs and is in compliance with ACA standards.

I have read the rules. I understand any major infraction of these rules will be sufficient cause for my participation in the above-named event to be terminated and being sent home at my own expense.

I hereby authorize the release of all medical records (x-rays, test results, etc.) resulting from treatment to the Church of God of Prophecy Idaho Youth Camp.

COVID policy: Please do not send your child to camp if they have COVID like symptoms; a refund will be offered if a camper becomes ill prior to the first day of camp. A COVID test will be given if a person exhibits COVID like symptoms while attending camp. If a positive test result occurs the camp director will contact the parent or guardian to arrange to have the camper picked up. Email notifications will be sent out if we become aware of a possible COVID exposure occurring during camp.
