Joseph’s Story

(Genesis 37; 39:1–42:8; 45:1–3; 50:20)

1. Joseph’s brothers were jealous and sold him, and he was taken far from home.
 2. Even when Joseph was treated unfairly, God was with him and helped him.
 3. Joseph went through hard times, including being put in prison—but he didn’t lose hope.
 4. God raised Joseph up to a place of leadership where he could help many people.
 5. Joseph saw that God used everything—even the hard parts—for good, and he chose hope.
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Ask Me This!

(Great for the ride home, bedtime, or around the dinner table)

1. **What did Joseph's brothers do to him?**
 *Genesis 37:23–28* — They sold him and sent him away.
 2. **Was God still with Joseph during hard times?**
 *Genesis 39:2* — Yes, God was with him.
 3. **What happened to Joseph after he was put in prison?**
 *Genesis 41:39–41* — God helped him become a leader in Egypt.
 4. **How did Joseph respond to his brothers later?**
 *Genesis 45:1–3* — He forgave them and showed kindness.
 5. **What does Joseph's story teach us?**
 *Genesis 50:20* — God can use hard things for good.
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Take Off!

(Try this together throughout the week!)

- **Tuesday:** Read *Genesis 39:2* and talk about how God is with us in every situation.
 - **Thursday:** Read *Genesis 50:20* and talk about how God can bring good out of hard things.
 - **Saturday:** Share a family story about a hard time that God used for something good.
 - **All Week:** Say together:
“I can have hope no matter what!”
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Prayer Guide

I Can Have Hope No Matter What

Opening:

“Dear God, thank You for always being with us.”

Thanksgiving:

“Thank You for being with Joseph and working through his life.”

Confession:

“Forgive us when we lose hope or forget that You are in control.”

Prayer for the Child:

“God, help [child's name] trust You and have hope in every situation.”

Prayer for Strength & Trust:

“Holy Spirit, help [child's name] believe that You are working even when things are hard.”

Closing:

“Thank You for turning hard things into good. We trust You. In Jesus’ name, Amen.”

Parent Challenge

This week, talk with your child about **hope**—especially during difficult moments.

Read parts of Joseph’s story together and point out how God was with him every step of the way.

Encourage your child to trust God when things don’t go their way and remind them that God is always working behind the scenes.

End the week by praying together and thanking God for His faithfulness in every season.
