Hi Parents!

This week in KidZone, kids learned that we can trust Jesus and call out to Him no matter what is happening around us. The blind man in Luke 18 could not see Jesus, but he knew Jesus was near. Even when people told him to be quiet, he refused to stop calling out to Jesus.

Use this guide to continue the conversation at home and help your child grow in their faith!

Jesus Heals the Blind Man

Luke 18:35–42

- A blind man was sitting beside the road when he heard that Jesus was passing by.
- Even though he could not see Jesus, he believed that Jesus was there and began calling out to Him.
- The people around him told him to be quiet, but he would not stop crying out to Jesus.
- Jesus stopped and asked what the man wanted. The man asked Jesus to give him his sight.
- Jesus healed him because of his faith, and the man followed Jesus and praised God!

The blind man teaches us that we don't have to see everything to trust Jesus. We may not know what is going to happen or understand what God is doing, but we can still call out to Him and trust that He is with us.

Sometimes people may tell us to be quiet about our faith, make fun of us, or discourage us from following Jesus. But just like the blind man, we can keep calling out to Jesus and keep trusting Him!

Ask Me This!

Great for the ride home, bedtime, or around the dinner table

1. What did the blind man do when he heard Jesus was passing by?

 Luke 18:38 — He called out to Jesus and asked Him for help.

2. Could the blind man see Jesus?

 Luke 18:35 — No, he was blind, but he believed Jesus was there.

3. What did the people around him tell him to do?

 Luke 18:39 — They told him to be quiet, but he called out even louder.

4. What did Jesus do when the blind man called out to Him?

 Luke 18:40–42 — Jesus stopped, listened to him, and healed him.

5. What does this story teach us?

 Luke 18:42 — We can trust Jesus, call out to Him, and have faith even when our situation seems impossible.

Take Off!

Try this together throughout the week!

- Tuesday: Read Luke 18:38–39. Talk about a time when it might be difficult to stand up for your faith. Remind your child that they can always call out to Jesus.
- Thursday: Read Mark 10:27 together. Talk about something that seems impossible and remind your child that nothing is impossible with God.
- Saturday: Talk together about a time when you had to trust God even though you couldn't see or understand what was going to happen. Ask your child, “How can we keep trusting Jesus when we don't know what will happen?”
- All Week: Say together:
“I can trust Jesus and call out to Him no matter what!”

Prayer Guide

I Can Trust Jesus and Call Out to Him No Matter What

Opening:

“Dear God, thank You for always being with us and listening when we call out to You.”

Thanksgiving:

“Thank You for Jesus and for the way He showed love and compassion to the blind man.”

Confession:

"Forgive us when we are afraid to trust You or when we listen to what other people say instead of listening to You."

Prayer for the Child:

"God, help [child's name] have faith like the blind man. Help them trust You and call out to You whenever they need help."

Prayer for Strength & Courage:

"Holy Spirit, give [child's name] courage to follow Jesus even when other people disagree, make fun of them, or tell them to be quiet."

Prayer for Faith:

"Help [child's name] remember that You can do what seems impossible and that You will always be with them."

Closing:

"Thank You for hearing us when we call out to You. Help us trust You in every situation. We know that nothing is impossible with You. In Jesus' name, Amen."

Parent Challenge

This week, look for opportunities to remind your child that they can always call out to Jesus.

Talk about situations where your child might feel afraid, discouraged, left out, or pressured to be quiet about their faith. Remind them of the blind man in Luke 18. He couldn't see Jesus, and other people tried to make him quiet, but he kept calling out to Jesus because he trusted Him.

Encourage your child to pray when things seem impossible and to keep trusting Jesus even when they don't understand what is happening.

Ask them throughout the week:

"What can you do when you need Jesus' help?"

Then remind them:

"Call out to Him. He hears you, and He is with you!"
