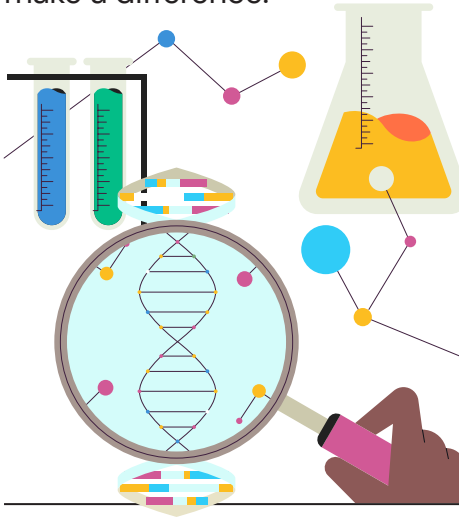


# Made: Discover who you're meant to be
