Liturgist: Early in the morning surrounded by self-interested religious leaders, anxious civic officials and silent friends, you accepted the penalty for doing good, for being Immanuel, God-with-us.

People: You shouldered, carried, and suffered the cross while those about you jeered and cheered.

All: And it concerns us dear God with whom would we have stood had we been there on that perilous day.

Liturgist: Early in the morning a voice in a guarded graveyard and footsteps in the dew proclaimed that you had risen from the dead,

People: announcing the startling news that you had come back to claim as your beloved own, those who had forgotten, denied, and destroyed you.
