Steeple Repairs

After 70 years of exposure to the elements, portions of the interior structure of Covenant's steeple have deteriorated and need repair. Upon consultation with a respected structural engineering company and their roofing partner, we have a plan for repairs that will be completed in 2 phases. Phase one begins this summer and will include replacing the upper-level wood deck with metal grating and adding steel supports. We expect the repairs to take several weeks to complete. The second phase is planned for 2027. After the completion of repairs, it is our vision that the steeple will continue to be a beacon to the city, inviting all into a vibrant and transformative faith community.
