

The 'I Am' Series – Family, Church & Prayer Guide

Week 1 – I Am the Bread of Life (John 6:35)

Family Talk-Back Questions

- What are some things we run to when we feel empty?
- How is Jesus different from physical bread?
- What would it look like for our family to feed on Christ this week?
- What habits help us stay spiritually full?

Church / Small Group Questions

- Why did the crowd want Jesus — for bread or for salvation?
- What modern substitutes do Christians use instead of Christ?
- How do we cultivate hunger for righteousness?
- How does communion reinforce this truth?

Personal Reflection

- Where am I spiritually hungry right now?
- Am I feeding daily on Christ through the Word and prayer?

Prayer Focus

- Lord Jesus, You are the Bread of Life. Create in us a deeper hunger for You.
- Help our family depend on You daily and not on temporary substitutes.
- Satisfy our souls with Your presence and truth.

Week 2 – I Am the Light of the World (John 8:12)

Family Talk-Back Questions

- What are some dark things people struggle with?
- How does Jesus help us see clearly?
- How can our home reflect His light?

Church / Small Group Questions

- What does walking in darkness look like practically?
- How do believers shine light in culture without compromise?
- Why is truth inseparable from light?

Personal Reflection

- Is there an area of hidden darkness in my life?
- Am I reflecting Christ or blending in?

Prayer Focus

- Jesus, shine Your light into every dark place in our hearts.
- Expose sin gently and lead us into truth.
- Make our home and church a beacon of Your light.

Week 3 – I Am the Good Shepherd (John 10:11)**Family Talk-Back Questions**

- What makes a good shepherd?
- How does Jesus show sacrificial love?
- How do we recognize His voice?

Church / Small Group Questions

- Contrast hired hands vs. the Good Shepherd.
- How does this shape pastoral leadership?
- What does it mean to be known by Christ?

Personal Reflection

- Am I listening to His voice?
- Where do I need to trust His leading?

Prayer Focus

- Good Shepherd, teach us to hear and follow Your voice.
- Lead our families with wisdom and gentleness.
- Thank You for laying down Your life for us.

Week 4 – I Am the Way, the Truth, and the Life (John 14:6)**Family Talk-Back Questions**

- Why can there not be many ways to God?
- What makes truth absolute?
- How does following Jesus affect everyday decisions?

Church / Small Group Questions

- How do we respond to claims that all religions are equal?

- What does it mean that Jesus is the Truth?
- How does this shape evangelism?

Personal Reflection

- Is Christ my authority?
- Am I walking in obedience to His way?

Prayer Focus

- Lord, keep us grounded in Your truth.
- Give us courage to stand firm in a confused world.
- Guide our steps in Your way daily.

Week 5 – I Am the True Vine (John 15:5)

Family Talk-Back Questions

- What happens when a branch is cut off?
- What does it mean to abide?
- What fruit should our family show?

Church / Small Group Questions

- What is the difference between activity and fruitfulness?
- How does abiding relate to prayer?
- What areas need pruning?

Personal Reflection

- Am I connected to Christ or just religiously busy?
- Is spiritual fruit evident in my life?

Prayer Focus

- Father, keep us abiding in Christ.
- Prune what is unfruitful in our lives.
- Produce lasting fruit through us for Your glory.

Week 6 – I Am the Resurrection and the Life (John 11:25)

Family Talk-Back Questions

- Why do people fear death?
- How does Jesus change how we view funerals?
- What hope do believers have?

Church / Small Group Questions

- Why did Jesus delay before raising Lazarus?
- How does this strengthen faith?
- What does life now mean in Christ?

Personal Reflection

- Do I truly believe in eternal life?
- Is my hope anchored in resurrection power?

Prayer Focus

- Jesus, anchor our hope in Your resurrection power.
- Strengthen our faith when we face loss or grief.
- Help us live with eternity in view.
