PROBLEMS OR ISSUES THIS BOOK IS ADDRESSING:

- The letter was addressed to Paul's young disciple Timothy, who may have been experiencing some burnout as most pastors do at times. Paul is encouraging him and advising him.

MOST FAMOUS VERSES:

Don't let anyone look down on you because you are young, but set an example for the believers in speech, in conduct, in love, in faith and in purity. **1 Timothy 4:12**

For the love of money is a root of all kinds of evil. Some people, eager for money, have wandered from the faith and pierced themselves with many griefs. **1 Timothy 6:10**

Important Points about the Book:

- Paul begins 1 Timothy by encouraging him to fight the good fight and not to let his young age be a hindrance.
- He then gives instructions for Timothy about leadership and managing all of the different situations he will encounter in the church community. These passages have been used over the centuries to train people in church leadership.

Paul writes this letter near the end of his life to his close friend and coworker Timothy. This personal letter is filled with Paul's encouraging words and wise counsel for this young leader. After working with him in Ephesus, Paul has assigned Timothy to lead the Ephesian church. Since this church is struggling with doctrine, religious practice, church government, and various aspects of Christian living. Timothy is in a difficult position as he tries to navigate his way through these issues. Paul clarifies some practical issues concerning church leadership, worship, and the conduct of widows, the elderly, slaves, and masters. Paul also writes to encourage Timothy to live wholeheartedly for the glory of God and not to become weary in his Christian life.
