Liam Carr: with Mission Sending Service in Taiwan. Liam is married to Mary. They are working with Joel and Judy Linton in Yilan County, planting a church.

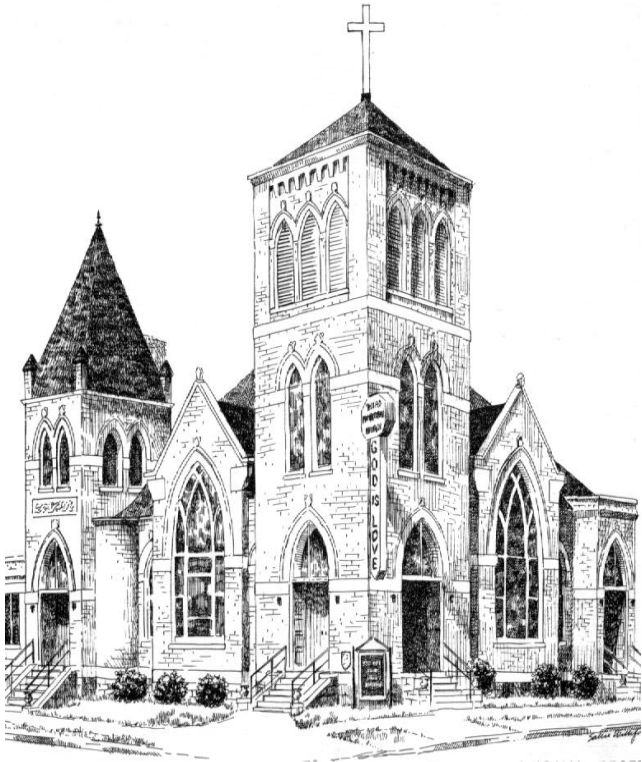
Summer Schedule for Children During Worship and Sunday School
