

STEPS OF A BIBLICAL WORD STUDY



OBSERVE THE PASSAGE

- Read the entire passage/chapter.
- Who is speaking in this passage?
- Who is the audience?
- What is the historical setting? Is it a time of war? Of celebration? Of lament?
- What stands out to you in this passage?



IDENTIFY THE WORD

- What word stands out in this passage?
- What is the Biblical definition of this word?
- What is the original Hebrew, Greek or Aramaic word used in this passage?
- What are English synonyms you would use for this word?



STUDY OTHER PASSAGES WITH THE SAME WORD

- Compare your passage with three to four other passages/verses that contain this same word.
- Is the context/setting the same or different?
- How is this word used in the other passages?
- Jot down quickly what each passage teaches you about this word.



PRACTICAL APPLICATIONS & OBSERVATIONS

- What does this teach you about God/Jesus?
- What did you learn?
- What does the world want us to believe about this?
- How can you apply it to your own life and glorify God?
