DISCUSSION QUESTIONS:**Read 1 Corinthians 3:10-23.**

1. According to verses 10, Paul calls himself a skilled master builder. What does he say is the source of this ability? And in verses 18-23, what else should we acknowledge as the source of our ability to build God's Church?
2. What is the foundation that Paul is referring to in verse 10? (See verse 11.) In your own words describe the importance of a building's foundation. What is the significance of Jesus Christ being the foundation of the Church?
3. What other resources are important in building God's Church? How do you think we can distinguish between those resources that will last and those that will perish through the fire? How do verses 12-15 encourage you or challenge you in your personal involvement with FRC as your church?
4. What is the significance of Paul telling the Corinthian church that they are God's temple in verses 16-17? How do these verses remind us of the importance of being set apart for God's purpose? What do these verses tell you about how God feels about His Church in the world, and FRC particularly?
