**THE POWER & WISDOM OF GOD**

1 CORINTHIANS 1:18-25 | PASTOR DANNY MARTINEZ

**Big idea:** God's \_\_\_\_\_ in the church is not in our brilliance or impressiveness but in Christ \_\_\_\_\_.

1. The \_\_\_\_\_ is the \_\_\_\_\_ that saves (V.18).

2. The \_\_\_\_\_ is the \_\_\_\_\_ that humbles human pride and wisdom (V.19-21).

3. The \_\_\_\_\_ is the \_\_\_\_\_ that forms a set-apart church with a clear message (V.22-25).

**Discussion Questions:**

**1. In 1 Corinthians 1:18, Paul says the message of the cross is “foolishness” to some and “the power of God” to others. What does that reveal about what the gospel is doing, and how does the thief on the cross help you see the simplicity of saving faith (Luke 23:39-43, Ephesians 2:8-9)?**

**2. In 1 Corinthians 1:19-21, how does God confront human pride and our desire to be impressive? Where are you tempted to trust brilliance, control, or approval more than Christ crucified, and what would humble repentance look like this week (Proverbs 3:5-6, James 4:6-10)?**

**3. In 1 Corinthians 1:22-25, people want signs or wisdom, but Paul preaches Christ crucified. How does the cross form a church that is set apart with a clear message, and how does it fuel our mission to know God and make Him known (Matthew 28:18-20, 2 Corinthians 5:20)?**

**4. What would it look like for the gospel to be the clear priority in your personal life and in our church life? How should Christ crucified shape the way we treat others, pursue unity, and engage our community, so that church is not mainly about programs but about grace filled growth and witness (1 Corinthians 1:18, John 13:34-35, Colossians 3:12-14, Matthew 5:14-16)?**
