DISCUSSION QUESTIONS:

1. Whether we are old or young believers, we all struggle with being “fleshly” in certain areas of our lives. In what subtle ways do we allow ourselves to not live in the full power of God’s Spirit, and instead react to challenges as “infants in Christ”? (Romans 8:5-6)

2. Paul was writing to an incredibly gifted church, yet they still experienced so much division because they anchored their loyalty to different human leaders. Why do you think spiritual gifts and outward ministry success often fail to produce genuine unity, and how can we protect ourselves from creating subtle “camps” based on our personal preferences? (Ephesians 4:1-3)

3. We are called to the faithful work of planting and watering, but God alone can change a heart and bring growth. How does knowing this keep us humble when things go well, and keep us from giving up when we feel like we’ve failed? (Isaiah 55:10-11)
