Discussion Questions:

The early church had intense debates over eating meat sacrificed to idols. What are some modern “grey areas” where Christians today might have very different convictions about what is acceptable to do? (1 Corinthians 8:4-8, Romans 14:1-4)

Paul warns that simply knowing we have the “right” or “freedom” to do something can make us arrogant, while love builds others up. When have you seen someone’s insistence on their personal rights cause damage to a relationship or a community? (1 Corinthians 8:1-3, 1 Corinthians 13:2)

What does it actually look like to be a “stumbling block” to someone else? Share a time when you chose to limit a personal freedom you enjoyed for the sake of another believer’s conscience. (1 Corinthians 8:9-12, Galatians 5:13)

Paul said he would willingly give up a right forever if it protected a fellow believer from falling. Practically speaking, how can we ensure that our love for one another always takes priority over exercising our personal freedoms? (1 Corinthians 8:13, Romans 15:1-2)
