GAME TIME! A GRATEFULNESS GAME

Print a copy for each player. Randomly pick a letter from the alphabet for each category (everyone uses the same set of category letters). Set a timer for 5 minutes. Each player lists as many things in each category that correspond to the category letter as possible before the timer goes off. After time is up, read through your lists. Award one point for every unique word listed. (A double word, like pumpkin patch, would get two points). If an answer matches another player, neither player can count the word. Player with the most points wins. Play again with new letters!

Sweet & Salty

FALL SNACK MIX

Baking with your kids is a treat for everyone! This is a very low-mess-easy-for-everyone recipe that is sure to please. Share it with a neighbor for a fun service project!

Ingredients

3 cups Peanut Butter Chex Cereal
2 cups Wheat Chex Cereal
2 cups bite-size pretzels
2 cups Cheez-Its
2 cups Honey Nut Cheerios

2/3 cup unsalted butter, melted
2/3 cup light brown sugar, packed
2 tablespoons maple syrup
1 teaspoon salt
1/2 teaspoon cinnamon
2 cups mini marshmallows
1 cup candy corn
1 cup Reese's Pieces

Directions

- Preheat your oven to 275 degrees F.
- Line two baking sheets with parchment paper. Set aside.
- In a large bowl, toss together the Chex cereals, mini pretzels, Cheez-Its, and Honey Nut Cheerios
- Whisk together the melted butter, brown sugar, syrup, salt, and cinnamon. Pour mixture over the snack mix and stir evenly to coat.
- Spread this mixture onto the prepared baking sheets. Bake 25 minutes or until mix starts to turn golden brown. Stir every 10 minutes.
- Remove from the oven and cool completely. Stir in the marshmallows, candy corn, and Reese's Pieces.
- Enjoy immediately or store in an airtight container for up to 1 week.

Connect as a family with this mix of meaningful and silly prompts to get them talking while you eat together.

Eating together as a family fosters family bonding, healthier eating habits, self-esteem, social skills, and more.



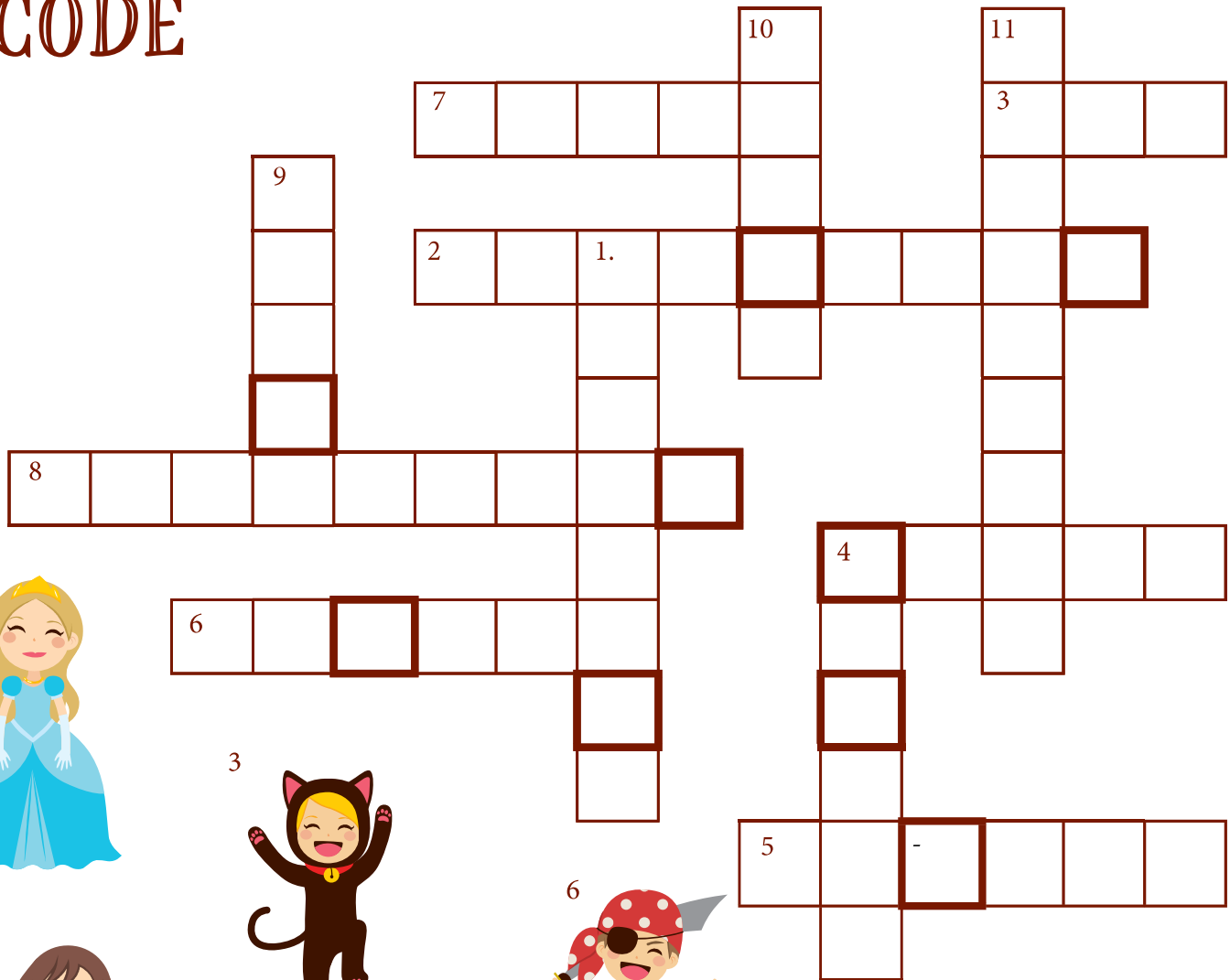

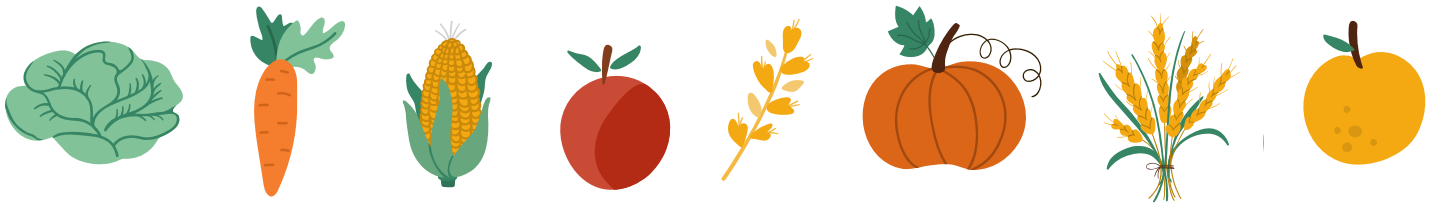

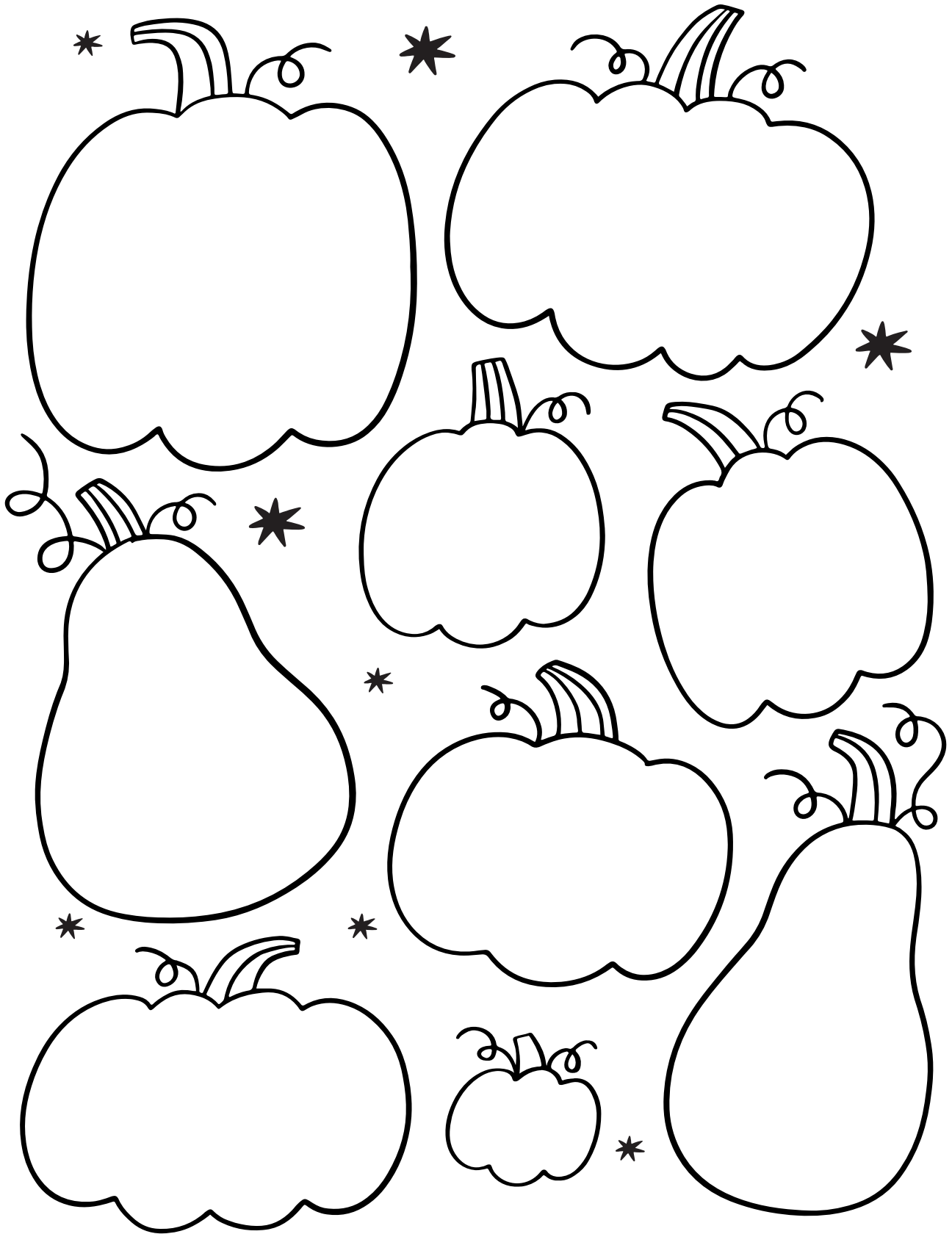
