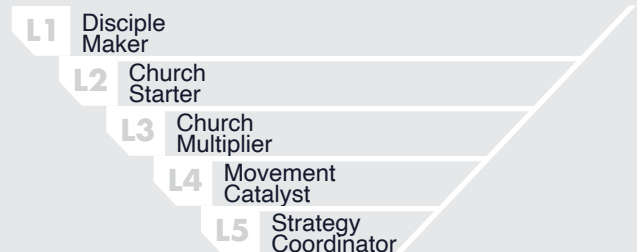
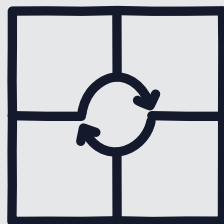

Minimum of Church

The church is followers of Jesus committed to one another and God's mission together.

Voluntary, Mutual Submission

God desires His church to voluntarily and mutually submit in love and service to one another (Ephesians 5:21, Galatians 5:13-15, 25-26).

Under the headship of Christ (Colossians 1:18) and the authority of Scripture and the Holy Spirit, every disciple humbly submits to one another. No one is above accountability from any disciple of Jesus.

We believe that there is no hierarchy in the kingdom. There are gifts of the Spirit and roles that serve God and the church. These serve humbly for God's glory and the benefit of others.

(1 Peter 5:3, Matthew 23:8-11, John 17:20-23).

Cross-pollinate Leaders

To love one another, spur one another on, hold each other accountable, identify best practices, identify & attack the gaps, and train new leaders.

Share Resources

We lay a foundation for God's people to live on less than we think we can live on AND give away more than we think we can AS AN ACT OF WORSHIP TO GOD to provide for the mission of God & the needs of His people.

We encourage everyone to give regularly to Apostolic Laborers and sacrificially to the needs of the church.

We expect needs to be met,

1. first, by the individual/family under God's provision,
2. then: See a Need, Meet a Need.
3. If you can't meet the need, bring it to the local church to meet together,
4. followed by the churches one relational step away.
5. Needs that remain are put to the larger network through lines of relationship to be prayerfully considered by other disciples, churches, and networks.

Colabor for the Vision

To multiply disciples and churches, raise up local elders, form city networks, send new laborers, and serve the priesthood where we already are and where the Gospel is not yet.

Leadership

We believe Jesus is the High Priest (Hebrews 3:1), Chief Apostle (Hebrews 3:1), Head of the Church (Colossians 1:18), and Chief Shepherd (1 Peter 5:4). He is over all.

We value and protect the priesthood of all believers so that we will proclaim the excellencies of Him who called us out of darkness into His marvelous light (1 Peter 2:9-10).

We appoint and develop elders to watch over and be an example for the local church (1 Peter 5:2) by stewarding healthy church, holding firm to Scripture, and encouraging every disciple to obey God (Titus 1:7, 9).

Each church is autonomous under the guidance of the Holy Spirit, and we voluntarily submit to one another - disciple to disciple, and church to church - through lines of relationship. Apostolic missionaries, church elders, and the priesthood work together to multiply and sustain disciples.
