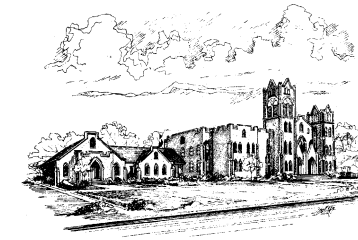
PEANUT BUTTER & JELLY SUNDAY
