The Son Is Fully God — Coequal and Coeternal with the Father

According to John 1:1, the Word was with God, and the Word was God.

The Son Is Not Made

John 5:26 says the Father has life in Himself and gave the Son to have life in Himself.

The Son's relationship to the father has no **beginning**; it is eternal.

The Son Reveals the Father

John 14:9 — “He who has seen Me has seen the **Father**.”

Hebrews 1:1–2 teaches that God has spoken to us in His Son.

The Son is the visible expression of the invisible **God**.

The Son Is the Redeemer — God Incarnate Who Took on Flesh

John 1:14 — “The Word became **flesh** and dwelt among us.”

The eternal Son became fully **human** to accomplish our **salvation**.

The Son's Role in the Trinity — Mediator and Lord

1 Timothy 2:5 — There is one **mediator** between God and men

Matthew 28:18 — All **authority** has been given to Me in heaven and on earth.

The Son Is the Baptizer with the Holy Spirit

Matthew 3:11 — He will baptize you with the Holy **Spirit**.

John 16:7 — “If I go, I will **send** Him to you.”

Romans 8:34 — Christ is at the right hand of God and **intercedes** for us.
