

## TYPES OF PRAYER

### Why Pray?

### 2. Prayer of Consecration

### 3. Prayer of Worship

Prayer that ministers to \_\_\_\_\_ rather than asking from Him.

Acts 13:2 – They were ministering to the Lord.

#### **4. Prayer of Agreement**

Two or more believers coming into \_\_\_\_\_ on the basis of God's Word.

Matthew 18:19 – If two of you \_\_\_\_\_ on earth...

#### **5. Prayer of Intercession**

Standing in the \_\_\_\_\_ for others.

#### **6. Praying in the Spirit**
