A Year That Changes Everything

This is a dedicated, nine-month season to step out of routine and intentionally pursue God. It's an opportunity to build a foundation that will shape the rest of your life.

Built Around God's Presence

Every part of the program is centered on developing a consistent and real relationship with God through worship, prayer, and the Word.

Real Discipleship

You won't walk this year alone. You will be mentored, challenged, and personally invested in by leaders who are committed to your growth.

PROGRAM OVERVIEW

The School of Leadership is a nine-month, full-time program designed to create an environment where students grow through teaching, discipleship, and hands-on ministry.

What to Expect

This is a full-time commitment from September through June. Each week follows a structured rhythm that includes:

- Daily worship and prayer
- Biblical teaching and classroom instruction
- Community and small group connection

Students will also participate in a mission trip to Costa Rica, partnering with local ministries to share the Gospel and serve communities in practical ways.

Additional Expenses

Students are encouraged to raise financial support for personal costs.

What's Needed

Requirements

- Ages 18–25
- Must be single
- Willing to commit fully for the entire program

What's Included

- Housing + Food (for girls)
- School-related travel + conferences
- Curriculum + supplies

Housing is available for female students, while male students are responsible for arranging their own housing locally.

The School of Leadership is a focused and intentional season. To create an environment where every student can grow, we ask for a high level of commitment, personal responsibility, and a willingness to be challenged.

Full Commitment

This is a full-time commitment. Students are expected to fully engage in the program.

FAQ

Who is the School of Leadership for?

The School of Leadership is for single young adults (ages 18-25) who want to grow in their relationship with God.

I am not planning on going into ministry, is SL for me?

Yes! Our goal is to equip you to live a healthy and whole life in Christ — whether that means your path is to be in the marketplace, a stay-at-home parent, or go into ministry. Our focus is to help you build a foundation to serve Jesus in any vocation or stage of life.

Can I work while attending the program?

We do not recommend working during your first-year, as the program is full-time and requires full focus.

Where will I live during the school year?

Housing is provided for female students, with meals included. Male students arrange housing locally.

Is there a mission trip?

Yes – students participate in a mission trip to Costa Rica as part of the program. The cost of the trip is included in tuition.
