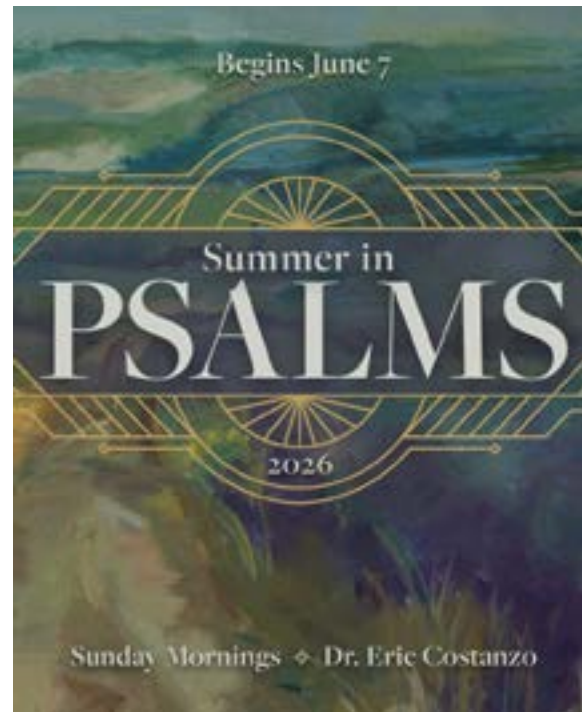

In April I shared that Falls Creek is a place that profoundly shaped my faith and calling to ministry. My prayer is that through this year's "Set Apart" theme, students will encounter God, discover His purpose for their lives, and be transformed as they learn to live differently for Christ. Pray that our students leave Falls Creek with a renewed passion to tell their friends, classmates, teammates, and family members about the hope they have found in Christ. Whether through conversations or simply living differently, students can be powerful witnesses for the Gospel. Please join us in praying that God would use Falls Creek (June 15-19) to help students know Him more deeply, love Him more fully, and share Him more boldly!
