John 14:15-31

1. What/who is the Holy Spirit?

Many people say the Holy Spirit is...

- God's force
- Like the wind
- God's Hands...

But the truth is, according to Jesus in John chapter 14, the Holy Spirit is a person. A person who is from the Father, and has many different attributes!

2. What does the Holy Spirit do?

Jesus tells us that the Holy Spirit lives inside every believer. True believers have the person of the Holy Spirit living within them, and He reminds believers of all that Jesus has taught and teach us... all things.

- The Holy Spirit's ministry is the continuation of the ministry of Jesus Christ, except the Holy Spirit is with all of us at once!

3. What does that have to do with being a living sacrifice?

Honestly, this has EVERYTHING to do with being a living sacrifice! It is impossible for us to be living sacrifices who are devoted to the Lord without the help of the Holy Spirit.
