Sermon Notes: Thursday, January 22 & Sunday, January 25

We are First United Methodist Church of Gadsden, and we are called to share Christ, make disciples, serve people, and give hope. We do this so that lives may be changed in the name of Christ. Giving hope may not be a tangible aspect of what we do, but it is an important part of what we do. Too often, people go through life expecting the worst, without passion, and not believing that there is something better ahead. Hope allows us an optimistic outlook. Hope in Jesus reminds us that the worst day is not our last, and we are not alone.

Psalm 62:5-8 is a song of hope and supports the source of our expectations in the Lord. It is an affirmation of where the Psalmist's hope comes. The Psalmist affirms that he is waiting for God, because is where he finds hope. God is hope because God is a rock, or a firm foundation. God is hope because God is salvation. God saves us from our troubles. He is our fortress and protects us in a time of need. He delivers us and rescues us. God is a refuge and we can always trust in Him. This is a comfort for us when we lose our way and a message for us as we seek to render hope to others.

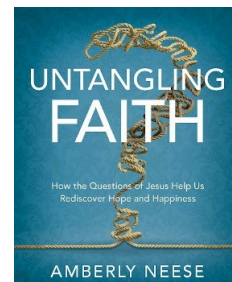


Bible Studies & Small Groups for Adults

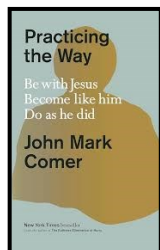

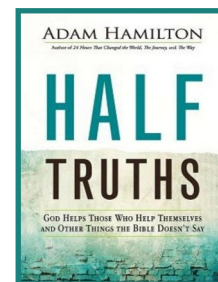

HAL RHEA



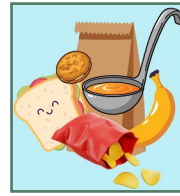

Mission Focus

Ladle of Love—Volunteer Opportunity

The **GFUMC Ladle of Love Ministry** is a weekly outreach dedicated to sharing nourishment, dignity, and hospitality with our community. Each week, a **team of volunteers** comes together to prepare and pack approximately **100 take-out lunches**, offering a simple but thoughtfully prepared meal to anyone who comes. A typical lunch includes a **sandwich, chips, fruit, and a dessert**—often an individually wrapped Little Debbie. At times, the menu may vary and include options such as **barbecue sandwiches, soup and sandwiches, burritos**, or other hearty meals.



Lunches are distributed **every Friday from 11:00 a.m. to 12:00 noon** at the **covered portico facing 6th Street**. There is **no request for names, identification, or proof of eligibility**—all are welcome. To ensure fairness and availability, **one lunch is given per person present**. Through this ministry, GFuMC seeks to meet immediate needs while extending Christ’s love through compassion, generosity, and respectful service.

Volunteers are essential to this ministry’s success. We are currently seeking a **team leader and volunteers for the third Friday of each month**, and **additional volunteers are also needed for other weekly teams**. GFUMC Clothes Closet Ministry

The **GFUMC Clothes Closet Ministry** is a welcoming outreach that provides free clothing to anyone in the community who has a need. **Donations of clothing are received throughout the year**, helping ensure that the Closet remains well stocked for all seasons. At present, **seasonal winter items** are especially needed, including **jackets, sweaters, hats, gloves, scarves, and socks**. Simply call the church office to schedule a time to drop off items.



A dedicated group of volunteers works behind the scenes to make this ministry possible. Volunteers gather from **9:00 a.m. to 11:00 a.m. on the Tuesday preceding each open day** to **sort, organize, and prepare donated clothing**. The Clothes Closet is thoughtfully arranged **like a retail store**, allowing guests to enjoy a dignified shopping experience. Some volunteers even use their creativity to design **attractive window displays**, adding a warm and inviting touch.

The Clothes Closet is **open to the public on the first and third Wednesday of each month from 9:00 a.m. to 11:00 a.m.** All clothing items are **provided at no cost**, and there is **no requirement for names, identification, or proof of need**. Guests are simply invited to come in, browse, and select the **clothing styles and sizes that best meet their needs**. Through this ministry, GFUMC offers care, respect, and generosity to the community. **New Volunteers are always welcome!** Contact Susan Swann, 256.543.8200 for more information.

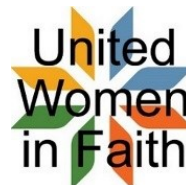

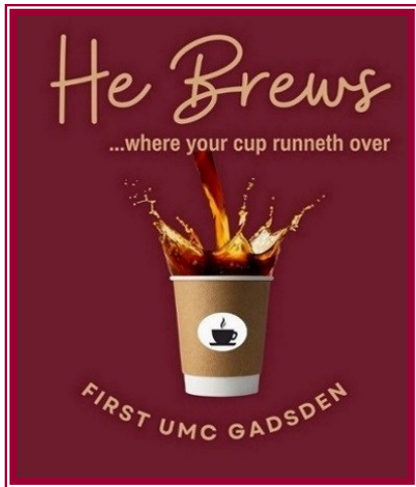
