**Annual First UMC Gadsden Safe Sanctuary Training**

**Sunday, September 22 @ 12:15 PM, Room 108**

Safe Sanctuary Training is required for ALL staff and volunteers who work in Children and Youth Ministry and open to everyone to attend.

**What is Safe Sanctuary?**

Safe Sanctuary is a policy that protects children, youth and vulnerable adults. Everyone (staff and volunteers) working with youth, children and vulnerable adults is required to complete Safe Sanctuary Training and Screening. The GFUMC Safe Sanctuary Policy includes the “2, 5, 6 rules”: 2 unrelated adults leading all ministry activities; volunteer leaders must be 5 years older than the group that they are leading; and volunteer leaders must be active in the church for at least 6 months. It also includes additional guidelines for chaperones, field trips, and overnight camping trips, as well as ministry with vulnerable adults.

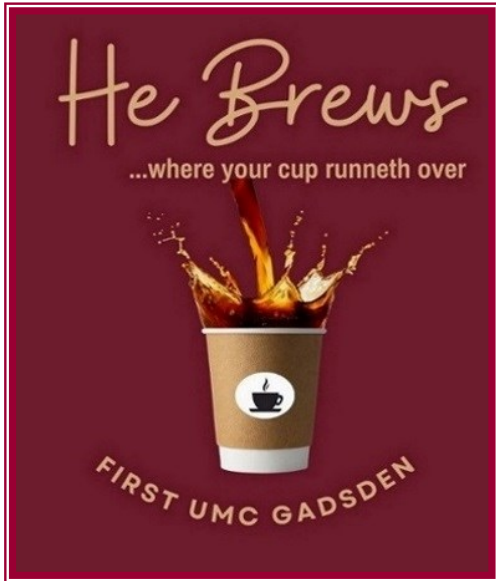

# September Mission Focus



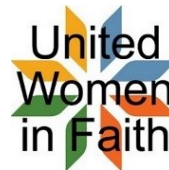

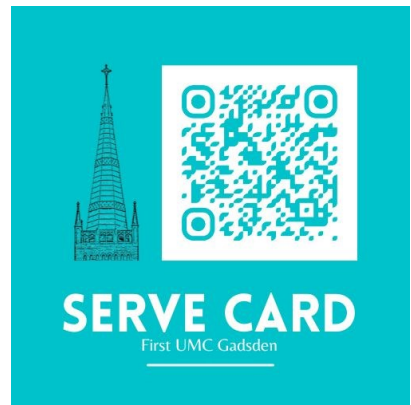
