Today's Bible Story: Jesus Heals a Woman on the Sabbath • Luke 13:10–17 CEV
Jesus cares about everyone every day.

Key Question: Who does Jesus care about?

Bottom Line: Jesus cares about everyone.

Memory Verse: *How wide and long and high and deep is the love of Christ.* • Ephesians 3:18 NIV

1. Help the Hurt

What You Need:

- “Help the Hurt” Person Outline Activity Page (one per child)
- Crayons and/or markers
- Adhesive bandage stickers

What You Do:

Before the Activity: Print one person outline per child. Set out crayons/markers and bandage stickers at the table.

During the Activity: Invite children to decorate their person by drawing a face, hair, and clothes. Encourage them to place bandage stickers anywhere their person might be hurt.

After the Activity: Look at each child's artwork and talk about how they helped take care of their person, just like Jesus helped someone who was hurting.

What You Say:

Before the Activity: “Hello, hello friends! I'm so happy to see you today! Today, we're going to make our very own picture of someone who needs help. We can draw their face, hair, and clothes, and then use bandages to help them feel better!”

During the Activity: “You are doing such a great job decorating your person! I see you giving them a big smile. Where should we put a bandage to help them? (Pause.) That's so kind! You are helping your person just like Jesus helped the woman who was hurting.”

After the Activity: “In today's true Bible story from Luke 13:10–17, Jesus saw a woman who was hurting, and He helped her. Jesus cares about everyone, every day—even on Sundays! We used bandages to help our pictures, but Jesus used His power to help the woman stand up straight again because He loved her. Isn't that amazing?! **[Bottom Line] Jesus cares about everyone. Who does Jesus care about? [Bottom Line] Jesus cares about everyone!**!”

2. Pray

“Let's pray. Dear God, thank You for loving us just like how you loved the woman who needed healing. What a great reminder that You care about everyone! We love You, God. In Jesus' name, Amen.”
