Week	Bible Story	Summary
1	God Made Me	God is creative, and He made so many things. He made EVERYTHING! The land and oceans and sky ... the big elephants and lions, the small turtles and grasshoppers—God made them all! But that's not all God made ... God made people! We don't have fur like a fox or scales like a fish, and we can jump high, but not as high as a kangaroo. But the Bible says: How you made me is amazing and wonderful (Psalm 139:14 NIV). God made everything in the whole wide world, but God made people amazing and wonderful.
2	Wonderfully Me	God made every part of us: from the tops of our heads to our wiggly toes. But God didn't make us all the same. Some people have straight hair, and some people have curly hair. God made some eyes brown, some blue, and some green! Some people use their mouths to talk, and some people use their hands for sign language. But every single person you meet is wonderfully made, because they were made by God.
3	God Made Me in His Image	God did something very special when He made people, because God made us to be like Him. Think about playing Follow the Leader. If I'm the leader and I raise my hands, then others will raise their hands too, right? Well, God is our Leader, and He wants us to do what He does. God is kind, so God wants us to be kind. God is loving, so God wants us to be loving. And when we are kind and loving, then other people will know that God is kind and loving. God wants us to show people what He is like, so God made us to be like Him.
4	God Knows Everything About Me	People are very important people to God. He loves us so much and knows everything about us. The Bible teaches us that God knows when we sit down and when we get up. He knows when we leave our home and when we come back. Even before we say a word, God knows what we are going to say! The Bible also tells us that God knows how many hairs are on our heads and He knows our names! God knows everything about us because we are important to God. In the New Testament, Jesus tells us that God takes care of the birds. But He also says that people are worth so much more than the birds! Jesus also told people that if someone gives just a cup of cold water to a little one who follows Him, then that person will be rewarded. That's how important we are to God!
5	God Loves Me	We know God loves us because He has given us a very special gift. But God's gift isn't in a box—it's too big! It isn't wrapped in beautiful paper, and we don't pull it out of a fun gift bag. God's special gift is a person: Jesus! Jesus is God's Son, and Jesus wants to be our friend forever. He is the best gift! But God doesn't give us this amazing gift because it's our birthday or because we've been really, really good. God gave us Jesus because He loves us. Jesus is a gift for every person God made.

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
