Note to Ministry Leader

The grocery store, doctor's office, playground, school, church ... preschoolers go to a lot of places! And while some places spark adventure and play, others can make preschoolers feel a little anxious or afraid. So, this month's memory verse is perfect for our busy preschoolers:

"God is with you wherever you go" (Joshua 1:9 ESV).

Preschoolers cannot see God, but they need to know that He is always with them. God is close enough to hear their giggles and tears, and He hears them when they pray to Him. So, we have four Bible stories to share this month that will help preschoolers learn this month's Bottom Line: God is always with me.

God's presence is a gift. He protects us. He provides for us. He helps and guides us wherever we go. So join us this month as we show preschoolers that God will always be with them, no matter what they experience. As we share these stories with preschoolers, let's pray that the Holy Spirit will help us demonstrate our own trust in God, so our words and actions point preschoolers to one undeniable truth: God is always with me.

Weekly Summaries

Week	Bible Story	Summary
1	God is always with me.	Daniel loves God, and he goes to his room three times every day to pray and talk to God. But one day, some people trick the king into giving a new command which says everyone has to pray to the KING ... and not God. And if they don't follow the command, they will be thrown into the lions' den. Well, Daniel keeps praying to God, and he is thrown into the lions' den. But God sends an angel to shut the mouths of the lions. Daniel comes out of the den without a single scratch, because God was always with Daniel. God is always with our preschoolers too.
2	God always hears me.	When Hagar and her son, Ishmael, run out of water in the middle of a hot desert, it is a desperate situation. But an angel calls out to Hagar, telling her that God has heard her son crying. God shows Hagar a well where she can get water for her son. God saw Hagar, and He heard Ishmael. And God hears our preschoolers too, because God is always with them.
3	God is with me wherever I go.	Joseph's older brothers don't like Joseph's special coat or his dreams, so they send Joseph far away to Egypt, where he starts working for a very important man. Joseph does well and is put in charge of the man's whole house. But it all falls apart when someone tells a lie about Joseph, and he is put in jail. But then Joseph helps Pharaoh understand that his strange dream means that a famine is coming! Pharaoh can see that God is with Joseph, so he puts Joseph in charge of Egypt to help them prepare. Through all the ups and downs, God was with Joseph wherever he went and helped him in everything he did. And God is always with our preschoolers too.
4	I can always talk to God.	God tells Jonah to go to the city of Nineveh, but Jonah doesn't do what God said. Jonah gets on a boat and goes the other way! But when a big storm threatens the boat, Jonah knows it is because of him. So, he has the men throw him off the boat and into the water, but God is with Jonah! God sends a big fish that swallows Jonah, and for three days, Jonah is safe in the belly of the fish, where he prays and talks to God. We can always pray to God, just like Jonah, because God is always with us.

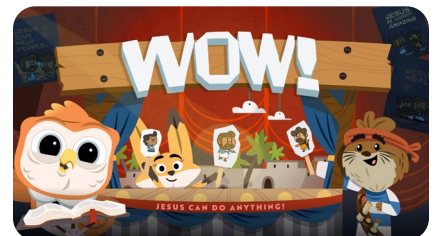

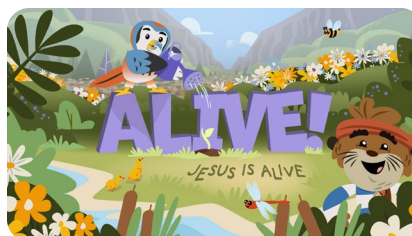

Social 15 minutes Providing time for fun interaction	Includes activities as preschoolers arrive. This time encourages preschoolers to enter the classroom and engage with peers and Small Group Leaders by providing fun, age-appropriate, hands-on activities that introduce new concepts they will hear in the Bible Story.	→ Plan for as many of the activities as possible. → Review the Small Group document for props and supplies needed.
Worship 10 minutes Inviting preschoolers to respond to God	We recommend worship songs that amplify teaching content for the month. We've created these songs to be developmentally appropriate, incorporating simple, direct language, fun dance movements, and upbeat, current arrangements. Songs are preloaded into APlay .	→ Recommendation: Have a Worship Leader and live instruments to sing along with the music tracks. → Encourage small group leaders to model what it means to worship by participating in worship using words and motions and encourage children to follow along. → Share music links with parents so they can stream them at home or in the car.
Story 10 minutes Communicating God's truth in engaging ways	Includes various methods of storytelling to engage every kid as they learn about God's Big Story and the part they can play in it. This time encourages kids to be active participants in their faith and not just bystanders.	→ Teaching resources have been curated to your environment—whether using media, live, or a hybrid of both. Live scripts are written to be "told" and not "read." Advance preparation is necessary.
Groups 25 minutes Creating a safe place to connect	Includes activities written to reach every learning style. These activities will reinforce the Bottom Line introduced during the Bible Story and help kids apply it to real-life experiences.	→ Plan for as many of the activities as possible. → Review the Small Group document for props and supplies needed. → You may want to lead one activity at a time. Or offer two activities at once and allow half the children to participate in each. Then switch groups and repeat the activities.

Whether kids are moving, creating, building, sharing, or imagining, each stamp shows how the activity is designed to help kids engage with God's Word in a way that sticks. They also ensure variety and balance in your time together.

How to Use

So as you plan, try mixing it up! You'll see an assigned Activity listed with each activity to show you how it's designed to engage kids best.

One week you might do a "Made to Move" activity, and the next week might be "Made to Create." Both help kids connect with God in meaningful ways.

Using a variety of activities throughout your time helps every kid feel seen and gives them a chance to connect with God's Word in a way that makes sense to them.

Create the Environment

General Tips

Declutter your environment. While relationships matter most, a cluttered space is less inviting.

Store toys out of sight and out of mind. It is difficult to engage a preschooler when their favorite toy is nearby.

If you share space with a preschool, develop a strong relationship with the preschool director and teachers. Don't let shared space become a source of contention. If possible, work together to sew fitted slipcovers for bookcases and cubbies to keep off-limit items out of sight. (Think BBQ grill covers.) Choose neutral-colored fabric or match the wall color so the covered furniture blends into the background. Set each other up for success by asking the preschool to cover everything before they leave on Friday and having your volunteers store the slipcovers before leaving on Sunday.

You don't have to go all out, but even little touches go a long way. Think about the theme art colors, or utilizing screens if you have them.

Display the Theme Art, Bottom Line, or Memory Verse in photo frames at check-in to help parents engage with what their child is learning.

Tips for This Month

Use these ideas as a starting point to bring the theme to life in your space.

September → Everywhere I Go: God is always with me. God is with our preschoolers everywhere they go, so let's create different locations to help them understand how big God is.

- Is God with you on the highest mountain?
Yes! So, make a mountain scene with butcher paper along the wall. To create a rocky texture, crumple the paper before spreading it out and attaching it to the wall.
- Is God with you on the playground? Yes! Create a playground with a toddler slide and a kite hanging from the ceiling.
- At every location you create, put a white map marker with the words "God is with me at the ___" to help parents make the connection.
- Continue the theme throughout your environment by adding footprint cutouts to the floors.
- Decorate walls with simple maps on parchment paper.

Create the Environment

October → Game Time: God's got it.

No matter the challenge, God's got it! Let's set up some sporty challenges for preschoolers as they learn to trust God. Use brightly colored tape to make hopscotch paths on the floor. (Want to protect your floors? Gaffer's tape won't leave adhesive residue on your floors.) Make a fun column out of beachball versions of baseballs, soccer balls, and basketballs. Use more sports beachballs to decorate throughout your environment. Hang a football over a goal post, a soccer ball in the goal, or a basketball in a basketball hoop. Decorate with pennant flag banners throughout your environment by hanging them from the ceiling or between traffic cones.

November → Tiny Parade: I can celebrate God.

November is a month of celebration, so let's set up our own tiny parade. Put plush animals and dolls in push cars, and line them up for a parade. For a fun touch, tape a pinwheel in the hand of each animal or doll. Decorate with large pinwheels, pennant flag banners, and balloons throughout your environment. Since latex balloons burst easily, use mylar balloons or reusable vinyl balloons. There's a lot of music at a parade and in this month's Bible stories, so you can also decorate with instruments and musical notes.

December → Come & See: Jesus is God's Son.

Christmastime is especially crazy in the life of a church, so choose traditional (and easily accessible) Christmas decorations. Haul out the Christmas trees and decorate with traditional, shatterproof ornaments. Place a few wrapped boxes underneath. Create a non-tree photo op by hanging construction paper garlands in Christmas colors. Hang Christmas lights everywhere, and set up a nativity so children are reminded that Christmas is a celebration of God's Son being born.

January → WOW! Jesus can do anything!

Let's 'wow' our preschoolers because Jesus can do anything. Get large, letter balloons to spell out 'Wow' and tape them to the wall. Put a big picture of Jesus (from the curriculum) next to the WOW balloons. Create a big tableau of the miraculous catch using fish cutouts. Or create waves from construction paper garlands made from light and royal blue, and put a boat cutout in the middle to remind everyone of Jesus calming the storm. Create an interactive element by setting up a puppet stage where kids can retell a Bible story. Puppets can be made from spoons or from illustrations in the curriculum.

February → The Everyone Club: Jesus loves everyone!

Jesus loves everyone, so create a clubhouse/treehouse where everyone can come. Make "wood" beams from strips of cardboard, and make signs that say "The Everyone Club," "You're Invited," and "Welcome." Add pictures of the preschoolers in your church or the treehouse characters. You could also set up a teddy bear picnic just outside the club. Make it personal by putting your preschoolers' names on the wall. Print in large letters so older preschoolers can recognize their name. Names can be on envelopes, as if they are invitations, or on small signs with hearts or stick-figure friends.

March → Alive! Jesus is alive.

No matter what the weather is like, make spring come alive in your environment. Cut large letters out of cardboard to spell the word 'ALIVE.' Paint the letters in bright colors, and glue inexpensive artificial flowers around the edge of each letter. Lay some artificial grass on the floor, and prop up the cardboard letters with self-adhesive easel backs. Tape honeybee cutouts on walls and add a loopy dashed line to show their flight path. Hang water cans with iridescent blue ribbons pouring from the spout. Consider decorating with potted plants, and then gift those plants to your fabulous Easter volunteers.

Create the Environment

April → Friends Forever: Jesus is always a good friend.

Let's go camping! Reuse the artificial grass from March, and set up tents on it. Roll up all the window flaps on the tents for safety and visibility if children will be playing in them. Decorate the camping scene with inflatable or cardboard fire props, plastic battery-operated lanterns, and camping chairs. Borrow artificial Christmas trees to create a forest, and make a "Friends Forever" banner to hang between trees. Add plush birds and forest animals to the trees. Decorate walls with paper doll chains, and continue the forest theme with leaf cutouts around doors.

May → Big Things: God helps me do big things.

It's time to go BIG! Create a sailboat out of cardboard. Connect two large pieces of cardboard at an angle to make the bow of the ship, and attach the opposite end to the wall, as if the ship is coming out of the wall. Hang the sail on the wall above the cardboard. Make giant waves from butcher paper. These can be simple cutouts, but you can also play with the butcher paper to create some 3D waves. Add some clouds on the wall with white butcher paper.

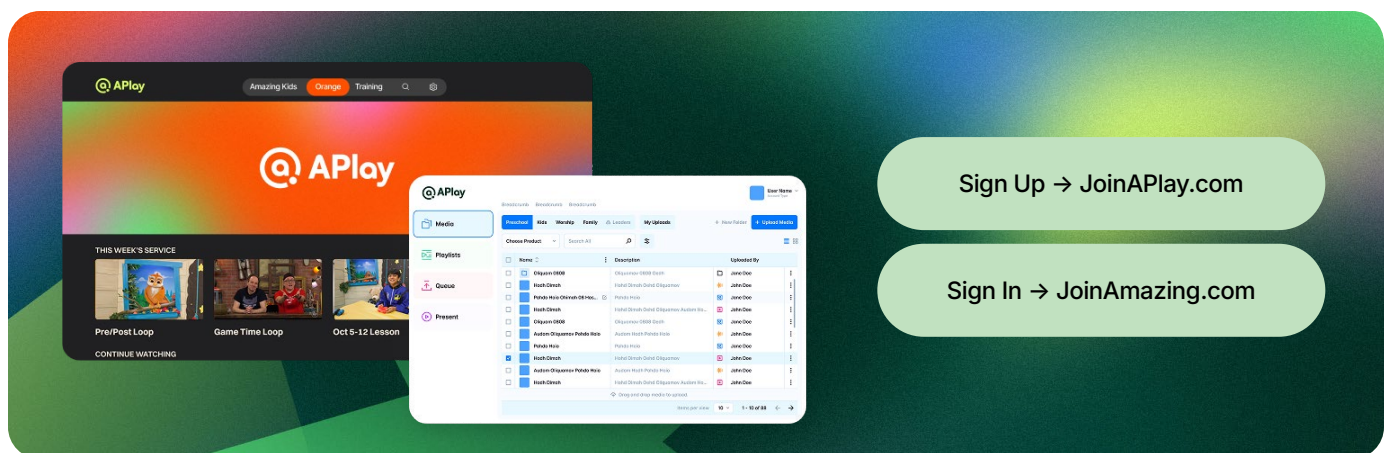

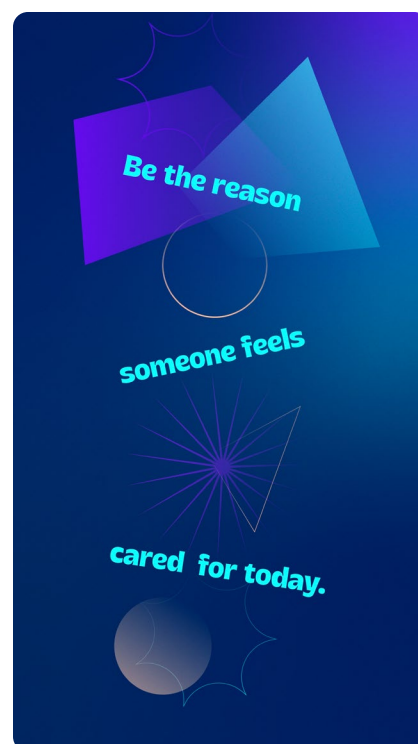
