Prayer Focus: “Men Strengthened to Lead in Christ: Praying for Men to Stand Strong, Love Well, and Lead God’s Way.”

IPM Foundation Scripture: **Romans 12:12** KJV Rejoicing in hope; patient in tribulation; *continuing instant in prayer.*

Weekly Prayer Focus

Week 1: Identity & Leadership- Leadership starts with knowing who we are in Christ. When our identity is secure, we lead with purpose, humility, and integrity-reflecting God’s heart in every area of life.

Weekly Scriptural Readings

- Romans 8:15 (NKJV)
- I Corinthians 16:13 (KJV)
- I Peter 2:9 (NIV)
- Proverbs 4:23 (MSG)

***Thought Provoking Question:** How would you define your God-given identity? Does your life reflect that identity daily?

Weekly Prayer Points

- Pray that men know who they are in Christ
- Pray for spiritual leadership in homes and communities
- Pray for courage to lead by example
- Pray for wisdom and discernment in decision-making
- Pray for integrity and obedience to God’s Word
- Praying that fathers and men understand their God-given identity and lead with humility, faith, and courage

Week 2: Healing & Wholeness- Many men carry wounds no one sees—pressure, disappointment, grief, guilt, and unspoken pain. Too often men learn how to cope but never learn how to heal. God calls men to be whole, not hidden. Healing is not a weakness; it is obedience. In this season, we focus on God's desire to heal men spiritually, emotionally, mentally, and physically, so they can lead, love, and serve from a place of wholeness. When God heals the man, He impacts the family, the church, and the community.

***Thought Provoking Question: In what ways might you be avoiding God's healing by trying to cope alone?**

Weekly Prayer Points

- Pray for healing from past trauma, rejection, and disappointment
- Pray for freedom from anger, pride, addiction, and shame
- Pray for healthy emotional expression and communication
- Pray for restoration in broken relationships
- Pray that men seek God instead of suffering in silence

Week 3: Responsibility & Provision- God called men, especially fathers to live with Godly responsibilities and faith provisions. Biblical provision is more than finances; it includes spiritual leadership, emotional presence, moral integrity, and faithful stewardship. Men are called to lead with courage, protect with wisdom, teach with patience, and serve with humility—trusting that God is the ultimate provider. When a man walks in obedience, diligence, and faith, he steps into the promise that God will supply every need according to His perfect will and divine purpose. Rise, men of God. Lead boldly, love deeply, and serve faithfully, knowing that every faithful step brings God's provision and blessing into your home, your family, and your life.

Weekly Prayer Points

- Pray for employment, stability, and financial wisdom
- Pray for discipline, accountability, and consistency
- Pray for fathers to be present and engaged
- Pray for men to model responsibility and faith
- Pray for strength to carry responsibility without burnout

Week 4: Legacy & Generational Impact- Our actions today shape the world of tomorrow. Legacy is the mark we leave, and generational impact is the ripple that carries our values, choices, and courage into the lives of those who follow. What we build now can inspire, uplift, and empower generations to come.

Weekly Scriptural Readings

- Proverbs 20:7 (KJV)
- Psalm 78:4-6 (NLT)
- Deuteronomy 6:6-7 (NIV)
- Genesis 18:19 (NKJV)

***Thought Provoking Question: Are there generational patterns you want to break?**

Weekly Prayer Points

- Pray for men to leave a legacy of faith and integrity
- Pray for fathers to disciple and spiritually cover their children
- Pray for the breaking of generational curses and cycles
- Pray for wisdom to guide sons and daughters in righteousness
- Pray for men to finish strong and remain faithful

Week 5: Faithfulness & Spiritual Growth- Spiritual growth doesn't happen overnight; it is cultivated through perseverance, obedience, and a daily commitment to God's Word. This week, we focus on praying that men remain steadfast in their faith, grow deeper in their knowledge of Christ, and live with integrity and consistency. True strength is shown not just in moments of leadership or provision, but in the ongoing pursuit of Christlike character and the discipline to follow Him faithfully, even when the journey is challenging.

***Thought Provoking Question: What steps can you take this year to grow deeper in your knowledge and grace in Christ?**

Weekly Prayer Points

- Pray for men to remain faithful in small and large responsibilities alike
- Pray for discernment to recognize God's direction and calling
- Pray for a heart that prioritizes eternal impact over temporary success
