1. Call to order

Jeremy Losier called this regular quarterly business meeting to order at 7:00 pm with an opening prayer.

2. Opening Exercise

Pastor read Matthew 25:14-30 for the opening exercise.

3. Reading of the Minutes

The minutes of the November 16, 2025, meeting were read by Ruth Miller. Minutes were approved as read.

4. Paster's Report

Pastor Jeremy gave his report. 2025 theme was 'Church 2.0' and the book of Acts. The theme for 2026 is 'Jesus is Better' and the book of Hebrews. (Pastor's report on page 14 of Annual report.)

5. Financial Report

Aaron Rush presented the financial report. Highlights include:

FBT Center Expense – The other expense of \$230.48 was for decorations for the FBT Center.

Missions - \$2522.47 for Operation Shoebox. Other missions included \$750.00 for women ministry class.

Christian Educations - \$468.75 for adult Sunday school class supplies and \$474.33 for hearing devices.

Outreach expenses - \$2195.55 for Thanksgiving food bundles and Giving Tree.

Other Expenses - \$1285.17 for One Call Now message service.

Capital Expenses - \$4050.00 to Burns Constructions for down payment on FBT Center storage addition.

6. Deacon's Report

Rusty McGrew gave the Deacon's report. Projects of the Deacons were the pastoral salary, meeting with Crossroads Fellowship, and continuous work on meeting the needs of the community. (Page 15 of Annual Report)

7. Trustee's Report

Scott Fred gave Trustee report. Projects completed included furniture for FBT Center lounge area, Paving of north drive to FBT Center, and approval of storage addition and handicap parking area at FBT Center. Church improvements included new roof, gutters and downspouts, sconces at east entrance, and carpeting of steps at south entrance. (page 16 of Annual report)

Scott reported that a State Building permit was needed to begin the construction of the FBT storage addition. This was an additional cost of \$2000. The Permit has been approved, and Scott will research and needed County permits.

8. Christian Education Report

Dave Emery gave the Christian Ed report. Education opportunities included FBT club and Youth Group attendance at 25-30 each. Senior study bibles presented, sent 24 kids to Twin Lakes Camp, VBS raised over \$1950.00 to send to Colton and Melodie Lee, Dodgeball tourney and Grace Graber Concert and presentations by Dan Herman and Gideons. 9. The FBT Center Hallelujah Report

A vision for community ministry began to be realized in 2018 with the purchase of land. After years of construction and hard work the building was completed in May of 2022 and was dedicated June 26, 2022. The final loan payment was made in January 2025 after a \$95,000 gift. Praise for the opportunities this building has given us to minister to the community.

10. Finance Team Report

Dave Emery reported on the Finance Teams 2026 budget. Capital Project budgets for 2026 include \$60,500 for FBT Storage, \$11,000 for Handicap parking, and \$3500 for Clavinova. (pages 10-13 of Annual Report).

11. Church Membership

Jeremy Losier noted that 2025 saw new membership by Baptism of Drew and Lucas Douglass. Death of Joan Harris was noted. (Annual report pages 42-44)

12. Old Business

No old business was discussed.

13. New Business

No new business was discussed.
