THE CHARGE OF JOSHUA, SON OF NUN

Israel had been led by Moses for 40 years from the time of Egypt through a tough wilderness experience lasting most of those 40 years. Joshua, the son of Nun, was a very particular military man from a very strong tribe in Israel (*Ephraim*) who had the pedigree necessary to lead God's people forward in victory to a new land that God had promised them (Num. 14:6-9; Ex. 17:8-16, 33:11). He was trained under Moses' leadership, but before this journey begins and Joshua takes the helm of this endeavor, he is _____ and ordained for the task.
