1) GOD IS L_____.

1 John 4:9-10 (HCSB)

9 God's love was revealed among us in this way: God sent His One and Only Son into the world so that we might live through Him. 10 Love consists in this: not that we loved God, but that He loved us and sent His Son to be the propitiation for our sins.

Moms are great at showing love. It's that display of love that helped me better understand God's love for me. That love was c_____ and s_____ and s_____. It all points to God.

1 Corinthians 13:4-8 (HCSB)

Love is patient, love is kind. Love does not envy, is not boastful, is not conceited, 5 does not act improperly, is not selfish, is not provoked, and does not keep a record of wrongs. 6 Love finds no joy in unrighteousness but rejoices in the truth. 7 It bears all things, believes all things, hopes all things, endures all things. 8 Love never ends.

Romans 5:5 (HCSB)

5 This hope will not disappoint us, because God's love has been poured out in our hearts through the Holy Spirit who was given to us.

There is a huge difference between h_____ that God is love and ex_____ God's love. A big difference!

A love that is willing to die, for you. When anybody talks about God's love, they go like this: **"God is love."** It is so universal. Great. God loves all His creation. Wonderful! However, it is deeper than that. It is more precious than that. It is intimate. It is sacrificial.
